IAREP/SABE/ICABEEP Summer School 2010 “Behavioral Economics and Economic Psychology”

Dear colleagues,

We would like to inform you that the IAREP/SABE/ICABEEP Summer School 2010 for PhD students and young faculty members on experimental and behavioural economics and economic psychology will take place from August 22 to September 3, 2010 in Moscow, Russia.

The school is organized by Laboratory of experimental and behavioural economics (<http://epee.hse.ru>) of the Higher School of Economics (HSE Moscow, Russia; <http://www.hse.ru/lingua/en/>)

Outline of the School

Location: National Research University - Higher School of Economics, Moscow, Russia

The university is conveniently located in downtown Moscow; about 30 minutes walk from the Kremlin, and close to most cultural attractions of the city.

Audience: 30 Ph.D. students and young faculty members in Economics, Psychology, and related disciplines recruited worldwide through an open call for participation. It is expected that up to 50% of the participants will represent developing countries, including Russia and other East European countries. Participants are not required to be well-familiar with the field of the school, but should be interested to working in that area in the future. All students are required to stay for the entire duration of the event.

Working language: English.

School description: The general aim of the Summer School is to involve the new generation of researchers into the field of behavioral economics and economic psychology, to provide participants with an interdisciplinary and open-minded view of the study of economic behavior and economic issues, to facilitate better mutual understanding of young economists and psychologists; to promote future interdisciplinary and international collaboration in the field.

We expect to have at least 6 international instructors representing both economics and psychology – leading researchers in the field.

The School programme will consist of general lectures (including open public ones) and group work in several (2-3) thematic areas determined by the interests and expertise of the instructors. Each thematic area will be explored by a group of 2 instructors and 10 students.

The School will end up with a 2nd mini-conference “Rationality, Behavior, Experiment” scheduled on 1-3 September 2010 (Previous conference - <http://www.hse.ru/org/hse/mief/rbe/>). We expect some of the invited speakers to participate in this mini-conference.

The university will provide full teaching facilities, internet access, library recourses, experimental laboratory, cultural programme.

ICABEEP membership for students:

Summer school students are granted free membership in IAREP and SABE (which also makes them members of ICABEEP) for 2010. (Notice that the registration fee of IAREP/SABE Conference 2010 in Cologne (<http://iarep-sabe.uni-koeln.de/conference.html>) includes

membership for 2011 (not for 2010), so the students are not exempt from paying the regular registration fee if they go to Cologne)

Financial conditions: will be announced shortly.

Applications: Applicants should submit a proposal (including an outline of an original research in the broad area of behavioural economics and economic psychology) through the School website to be set up in early January 2010 (link will become available at the IAREP and SABE websites).

Important dates:

Start for applications submission – February 1, 2010.

Deadline for applications submission – April 5, 2010.

Notification of acceptance – by April 23, 2010.

Arrival – August 22, 2010.

Departure – September 4, 2010.
