ADMISSION POLICY

Admission In Master 1

French and foreign students :

- Initial degree (Licence, or BA, BS) in psychology, economics or applied math (e.g. MASS)
- Students from grandes écoles:

Admission decisions are based on a letter of motivation, CV, transcripts of the previous three years of study, and any other element that the student wishes to provide such as letters of recommendation, etc.

Admission in Master 2

- Successful accomplishment of the M1
- Direct admission based on the evaluation of the candidacy can occur in exceptional cases.

Master 1st year (M1)

Provides the basis for a common training for all students.

- discovery of a new discipline (economics or psychology, depending upon prior training)
- Bi-disciplinary work during a Winter School (2-week intensive program)
- research project.

Master 2nd year (M2)

Focuses on the interface between economics and psychology.

- advanced courses in psychology and economics
- research seminars « Economics and Psychology »
- bi-disciplinary research project
- possibility for graduates to prepare a PhD in economics or psychology
- possibility to obtain the title of Psychologist after this Master (for those with a first degree in psychology)
